



## Rural Communities

Jurisdictions in rural counties and rural communities are eligible for Prospective Development awards. Rural counties are defined as those with a population density of fewer than 100 persons per square mile or a county smaller than 225 square miles, as determined by the Office of Financial Management (RCW 43.160.020).

**Rural communities** are defined by CERB to include the following:

- Clark County: Battle Ground, La Center, Ridgefield, Yacolt
- King County: Carnation, Duvall, Enumclaw, North Bend, Snoqualmie, Skykomish
- Kitsap County: Poulsbo
- Pierce County: Buckley, Carbonado, Eatonville, Roy, South Prairie, Wilkeson
- Snohomish County: Arlington, Darrington, Gold Bar, Granite Falls, Index, Lake Stevens, Marysville, Monroe, Shohomish, Stanwood, Sultan
- Spokane County: Cheney, Deer Park, Fairfield, Latah, Medical Lake, Rockford, Spangle, Waverly
- Thurston County: Bucoda, Rainier, Tenino, Yelm
