**CR-101 (June 2004)**  
(Implements RCW 34.05.310)  
Do **NOT** use for expedited rule making

**Agency:** Washington State Department of Commerce

**Subject of possible rule making:**  
Public Records  
Chapter 130-10 WAC and Title 365 WAC

**Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject:** Chapters 42.56 and 43.330 RCW

**Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:** This rulemaking is needed to updated Commerce's WACs implementing the Public Records Act to reflect changes to the statute, court decisions, and Commerce's organizational structure and record disclosure procedures.

Commerce's Public Records Officer will develop the rule updates in consultation with the Attorney General and Code Reviser's offices.
