

Weatherization Network & Committees

Weatherization Network (WX Network)

The Network provides a venue for the WX Advisory Committee and Disappearing Task Forces (DTF's) to present policy recommendations and strategic visions for discussion and feedback. Network meetings are intended to be work sessions for discussion and feedback on work performed through DTFs prior to scheduled meetings. Regularly scheduled Network meetings facilitate discussion and feedback about the recommendations and action taken. Every entity performing low income weatherization (including community action agencies housing authorities, municipalities, and tribal entities) is able to send one representative to Network meetings. Other interest may be invited to attend Network meetings including legal services, utilities, private contractors, housing non-profits, and others.

Weatherization Advisory Committee

The Weatherization (WX) Advisory Committee (Committee) provides leadership and serves as the principal steering committee to the Washington State Department of Commerce in partnership with the Washington State Community Action Partnership. Priorities include strategic planning, policy development, problem solving, and adopting best practices for weatherization and housing improvement programs. The Committee appoints or recruits volunteers to serve on Disappearing Task Force (DTF's) to solve problems and provide recommendations that will strengthen the weatherization network.

Technical Development Committee (TDC)

The TDC exchanges and distributes innovative ideas and remains current about new technologies and techniques in weatherization and rehabilitation programs. It provides policy and technical specification recommendations to Commerce and the Weatherization Network about building practices, technical advancements and innovative procedures in the energy conservation industry.
