Wall Heaters


Policy: Wall heaters must not be blocked.


Discussion: The following guidelines must be followed to prevent fire or premature failure of the wall unit.

- 1. No item should be placed within 6 inches of the heater.
- 2. Turning the thermostat "off" will not prevent the heater from coming on if the temperature inside gets cold enough. The thermostat does not turn the heater off.
- 3. Turning the heater off at the breaker is no guarantee that someone will not come by and turn the breaker back on creating a fire hazard.
- 4. Curtains/drapes should not hang closer than 12 inches above the heater.

Plan: Effective immediately all heaters must be cleared of all items. At no time are the heaters to be blocked.
