The proposed rules update Commerce's WACs implementing the Public Records Act, and move those rules from Title 130 WAC to Title 365 WAC. Reasons supporting proposal: Changes to the Public Records Act, court decisions, and Commerce's organizational structure and records disclosure procedures have made parts of Commerce's public records act rules obsolete. Rules are updated to reflect current standards and practices, and the Chapter is moved from Title 130 to Title 365 to better align with other Commerce WACs. In addition, WAC 365-04-030 is updated to reflect changes to Commerce's address and business hours.
