Application Instructions Lead-Based Paint Firm Certification

Who should use this application?

- •Firms applying for certification for the first time.
- •Firms applying for re-certification for lead-based paint activities.

Follow the steps below for completing the application process.

STEP 1

Complete the form Application for Lead-Based Paint Certification of a Firm including those items listed in the Application Checklist.

STEP 2

Review WAC 365-230 and become familiar with the requirements as they apply to firms and employees. Copies of the WAC are available on our website at www.commerce.wa.gov/lead.

STEP 3

Read and sign the Letter of Compliance on the bottom of the application form. The letter of compliance must be signed by a corporate officer, firm owner, or authorized agent of the firm.

STEP 4

All firms must be licensed to do business in the state of Washington. Submit documentation that the firm meets one of the following:

Registered Contractors – You must provide proof that you are a currently registered contractor with the department of Labor and Industries, including meeting the requirements for surety bond and insurance. This documentation is available from your local L&I office or you can print it from the L&I website at www.lni.wa.gov, click on the Trades and Licensing link.

OR

Environmental Consultants - If your firm is not a WA state-licensed contractor, you must include documentation that the firm has in force a business insurance policy (e.g., liability, errors and omissions) in the minimum amount of \$500,000.

NOTE: If you are not currently licensed to conduct business and construction activities in Washington State, you should contact the Business Licensing Service and Department of Labor and Industries to determine your requirements for licensing, contractor registration and worker compensation prior to performing abatement work in this state. Contact the Secretary of State's office for information regarding registering as a Washington Corporation.

STEP 5

Mail your application packet with the required \$25 fee for each firm application. Send check or money order made payable to Commerce and completed application to: Commerce/Lead-Based Paint Program, PO Box 42525, Olympia WA 98504-2525.

NOTE:

Firms Completing Applications for Individuals For Lead-based Paint Activities (Abatement, Inspection, Risk Assessment)

If the firm assists in completing applications for individuals who are applying for certification under lead-based paint activities, please be aware of the following:

- Individuals must have an address and phone number different from the firm's.
- Individuals must sign and date the application.
- Commerce forwards all correspondence to individuals who have signed the application attesting to their willingness to comply with the work practice standards found WAC 365-230-200.
- Commerce forwards copies of the individual's approval letter and certificate to the firm upon written request of the applicant; however, the approval letter, identification badge, and certificate remain the property of the individual.
