## **REVIEW COMMITTEE EXPECTATIONS**

- 1. The eleven member committee must consist of representatives from the following:
  - a. The Department of Labor and Industries
  - b. The Employment Security Department
  - c. The Department of Enterprise Services
  - d. The Workforce Training and Education Coordinating Board
  - e. The State Board for Community and Technical Colleges
  - f. Two representatives from business
  - g. Two representatives from labor
  - h. Two representatives from the Washington Apprenticeship and Training Council
- 2. The review committee shall designate a chair to oversee the committee meetings.
- 3. The review committee shall establish criteria for ranking eligible applicants for matching grant awards.
- 4. The review committee shall submit its recommendations for matching grants to the director of Commerce.
- 5. The review committee shall establish measurable outcomes for reporting.
- 6. The review committee shall submit an annual report to the governor and appropriate committees of the legislature in accordance with the reporting requirements in RCW 43.01.036, by December 1, 2019 and by each December 1 of each year thereafter.

Program runs through June 30, 2022 – appropriation to the account is not required

Received \$150,000 per fiscal year, for 2017-2019 biennium Estimating \$70,000 per year will be available for matching grants
