Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) reduces or eliminates taxes that low-income working people pay and, if the credit exceeds the amount of taxes owed, a lump sum credit is paid to those who qualify; and

WHEREAS, the EITC has become one of the nation's most effective tools for lifting low-income workers and their families above the poverty line; and

WHEREAS, together, the EITC and low-income Child Tax Credit (CTC) are among the strongest tools to promote work and help workers with children escape poverty and achieve self-sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, 407,000 Washington residents received \$893 million in EITC refunds in 2018, for an average refund of \$2,194; and

WHEREAS, individuals can receive a tax credit of up to \$6,431 if they meet eligibility requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Internal Revenue Service estimates just four of five, or 80 percent, of eligible taxpayers claim and receive this important credit;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jay Inslee, Governor of the state of Washington, do hereby proclaim January 25, 2019, as

Earned Income Tax Credit Awareness Day

in Washington, and I encourage all people in our state to join me in this special observance.
