


Applicant Responsibilities

- The Applicant is responsible for:
 - Reviewing the Notice of Funding Opportunity in its entirety
 - Reviewing the Q&A document prior to asking additional questions
 - Submitting the application in a timely manner late applications will NOT be accepted for any reason
 - Applications are due by 5:00 PM Pacific Time October 10, 2019
 - The accuracy and contents of the submitted application
 - Following the instructions as indicated on the application

 - Proposals to study the feasibility of stand-alone electrical generation projects



Available Funding and Match Requirements

- Available Furium Requirements Available Funding and Match
 - - There is \$482,768 available under a competitive application process.
 - Commerce anticipates making 3-6 awards of between \$20,000 and \$200,000.
 - A minimum 1:1 match of nonfederal funds, including cash or in-kind services, is required.




