These changes improve accountability of renewable energy claims by adopting an industry-standard definition of a renewable energy credit and expand the eligibility to hydropower to include federal projects marketed by the Bonneville Power Administration. WAC 194-40: The proposed new rules establish a new chapter for rules related to the Clean Energy Transformation Act (Chapter 19.405 RCW) and utility planning laws (Chapter 19.280 RCW). The new rule sections establish the purpose and scope of the chapter and establish specific cost values for consumer-owned utilities to use when incorporating the social cost of greenhouse gas emissions into planning, evaluation, and resource acquisition.
