Community Sexual Assault Program (CSAP): Grantees are expected to support and assist children, youth and adults (all gender) who have experienced sexual violence (abuse/assault). CSAPs are required to have a 24/7 hotline and must provide core advocacy services 24/7. Core Services are: crisis intervention, information and referral, general, legal and medical advocacy. *There are 37 CSAPs in Washington State.*

Crime Victim Service Center (CVSC): Grantees are expected to support and assist children, youth and adults (all gender) who have experienced "hurt or harm" (all crime types, other than dv, sa and stalking), regardless if the "crime" was reported to law enforcement or when the crime occurred. *There are 45 CVSCs in Washington State.*

\*\* Domestic Violence Legal Advocacy (DVLA): Grantees provide personal support and assistance to victims of domestic violence to ensure their interests are represented and their rights upheld within the civil and criminal justice systems; including administrative hearings. It includes educating and assisting victims in navigating the justice systems; assisting victims in evaluating advantages and disadvantages of participating in the legal processes; facilitating victims' access and participating in the legal systems and promoting victims' choices and rights within the legal system. *Note: There is a DVLA program in each county in Washington but not all of these programs receive CVSC/CSAP funding and are therefore not included in this list. SA: Grantees provide culturally and community specific support and assistance to children, youth and adults (all gender) who have experienced sexual violence (abuse/assault).
