Introduction

Background

During the 2019 session, the Washington State Legislature included a proviso for the Office of Homeless Youth to conduct a survey of available informational resources related to youth experiencing homelessness and youth in crisis services.

ESSB 6032.PL Sec. 127 (55) directed:

\$20,000 of the general fund – state appropriation for fiscal year 2019 is provided solely for the office of homeless youth prevention and protection programs to conduct a survey of homeless youth service and information gaps, especially in nonurban areas, with an emphasis on providing nonurban school districts with adequate informational resources related to homeless youth and youth in crisis services available in their community.

Purpose and methodology

The Department of Commerce has conducted a survey of homeless youth services and informational gaps that exist across the state. This summary report has been prepared to meet the requirements of the proviso and the Office of Homeless Youth.

The purpose of this summary report is to identify and catalog these resources for use by school district homeless liaisons throughout the state. This report used a broad scope to identify resources: all homeless services potentially available to public school students in grades kindergarten through 12th grade have been considered. Furthermore, this report uses the broadest definition possible for homeless youth, including both unaccompanied youth and those experiencing homelessness with their families. Students up to age 21 may attend Washington's public schools. Therefore, this report includes all homeless services available for youth under the age 18, as well as for adults between the ages of 18 and 21.

Federal law requires schools to identify students who experience homelessness, and to connect them with the services and supports they need to succeed academically. The McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. § 11434a(2)) defines homeless children and youth as "individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence." Generally, school districts identify students experiencing homelessness via an annual housing questionnaire, posting information on school grounds, or via a district homeless liaison¹. Children and youth are also identified by those served in any way through McKinney-Vento funds. Services may

include direct services, as outlined in the McKinney-Vento Act (42 U.SC. § 11433), or indirect services, such as those provided by a school or district staff member whose position is supported through McKinney-Vento funds.

This report draws on statewide services identified by Commerce's Housing Assistance Unit's "Golden" reports, rural county health departments, and the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI). The survey identified homeless youth services and information gaps, especially in nonurban areas, with an emphasis on providing nonurban school districts with adequate informational resources related to homeless youth and youth—in-crisis available in their community.

This study relies upon the census classification of rural school districts to determine nonurban areas. There are 215 school districts which meet the definition of nonurban, out of 294 total school districts.

The Homeless Student Stability Program within OSPI will distribute the information to school district homeless liaisons. It's important to note that the information in this report is accurate at the time of reporting but subject to change. Due to the limitations of the proviso, we are not able to continue to update this information.

Number of Homeless Students in Washington's Schools

In total, there were 11,427 homeless students in nonurban school districts counted by OSPI for the 2017-18 school year². This represents approximately 28 percent of the statewide total of all homeless students and an average of 53 homeless students per nonurban school district.

Of the homeless students, 1,150 were unaccompanied youth. This is an average of five unaccompanied youth per nonurban school district.

Fifteen counties do not have any services for homeless youth: Adams, Asotin, Columbia, Douglas, Ferry, Garfield, Grant, Jefferson, Kittitas, Lincoln, Okanogan, Pacific, San Juan, Stevens and Whitman. Total homeless students in Washington State, by school year

Available Services and Gaps

More than half – 58 percent – of the state's 215 rural school districts have no services for homeless youth either within their boundaries or within 10 miles of their district. Sixty-four rural school districts, or 30 percent of the total, reported homeless students and do not have any services available to them.




Figure 1. Rural School Districts (215) in Washington

There are 280 services available for homeless youth residing in rural school districts, as documented in Appendix B. In some locations, these services include emergency shelters, transitional housing or rapid re-housing. In other places, services are focused on efforts such as crisis intervention, counseling and homelessness prevention. Some providers offer a range of services while others have a particular focus such as shelter, prevention, street outreach or coordinated assessment.

The analysis demonstrates a stark difference in the availability and number of services provided between urban and rural areas with most providers located within major urban areas. Out of 280 total services, just 32 of these services are located in 13 rural school districts. Another 78


districts have services located outside their district, but within 10 miles of their district boundary. There are 124 districts with no services located in close proximity.

The 78 rural school districts with services located within 10 miles of their boundaries are generally located close to major urban areas. For instance, the Vashon School District has 105 services available if youth are able to go to Seattle, less than 10 miles away. However, the accessibility of these services is mitigated by the need to take ferry service to access them.

Appendix A: Total homeless students and services available, by school district

The following are unique counts of students identified as homeless during the 2017-18 school year. However, homeless students may be represented under more than one student group. Data was compiled from the OSPI report, "Homeless Student Count, by district (2017-18 school year)" published in 2019.³

In the original data, the following data markers were used:

- "N<10" refers to data that has been suppressed because the total is fewer than 10 students.
- "Complementary Suppression" indicates that data was suppressed because the count of smaller subgroups can be deduced by subtracting from the total.

For analysis purposes, both data markers have been converted to zero students in the following tables.

All services provided within the state are within 10 miles of at least one rural school district. However, a significant number of providers located within King County are located within 10 miles of only one school district (Vashon Island).

Appendix B: Homeless youth services by county

Fifteen counties have no services available for homeless youth: Adams, Asotin, Columbia, Douglas, Ferry, Garfield, Grant, Jefferson, Kittitas, Lincoln, Okanogan, Pacific, San Juan, Stevens and Whitman.

For the purposes of this analysis, unique services are listed separately even if they are delivered at the same provider and in the same location. This approach was used to help document the breadth of services available in each community or district. The following definitions of service types are from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development in its report, *HMIS Project Descriptor Data Elements*.⁴

- Emergency Shelter: a project that offers temporary shelter (lodging) for the homeless in general or for specific populations of the homeless. Requirements and limitations may vary by program, and will be specified by the funder.
- Transitional Housing: a project that provides temporary lodging and is designed to
 facilitate the movement of homeless individuals and families into permanent housing
 within a specified period of time, but no longer than 24 months. Requirements and
 limitations may vary by program, and will be specified by the funder.
- Rapid Re-housing: a permanent housing project that provides housing relocation and stabilization services and short- and/or medium-term rental assistance as necessary to help a homeless individual or family move as quickly as possible into permanent housing and achieve stability in that housing.
- Permanent Supportive Housing (disability requirement for entry): a project that offers
 permanent housing and supportive services to assist homeless persons with a disability
 (individuals or families in which one adult or child has a disability) to live independently.
- Housing with Services (no disability requirement for entry): a project that offers
 permanent housing and supportive services to assist homeless persons to live
 independently, but does not limit eligibility to individuals with disabilities or families in
 which one adult or child has a disability.
- Housing Only: a project that offers permanent housing for persons who are homeless, but does not make supportive services available as part of the project.
- Day Shelter: a project that offers daytime facilities and services (no lodging) for persons who are homeless.
- Safe Haven: a project that offers supportive housing that (1) serves hard to reach homeless persons with severe mental illness who came from the streets and have been unwilling or unable to participate in supportive services; (2) provides 24-hour residence for eligible persons for an unspecified period; (3) has an overnight capacity limited to 25 or fewer persons; and (4) provides low demand services and referrals for the residents.

- Street Outreach: a project that offers services necessary to reach out to unsheltered homeless people, connect them with emergency shelter, housing, or critical services, and provide urgent, nonfacility-based care to unsheltered homeless people who are unwilling or unable to access emergency shelter, housing, or an appropriate health facility.
- Services Only: a project that offers only stand-alone supportive services, to address the special needs of participants, such as child care, employment assistance, and transportation services.
- Homelessness Prevention: a project that offers services and/or financial assistance necessary to prevent a person from moving into an emergency shelter or place not meant for human habitation.
- Coordinated Assessment: a project that administers the continuum's centralized or coordinated process to coordinate assessment and referral of individuals and families seeking housing or services, including use of a comprehensive and standardized assessment tool.
- Other: a project that offers services, but does not provide lodging, and cannot otherwise be categorized as another project type, per above.
