# Application Instructions

## Lead-Based Paint Professional Recertification


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### Recertification Information

- All applicants for recertification must submit an application with required forms and supporting documentation.
- Recertification requires the applicant to complete an approved **refresher training course** prior to the expiration date for the specific discipline applying for, and submit the certificate with this application. Failing to attend class before your certification expires will require the applicant to take the entire initial class again and pass the state certification exam.
- The certificates issued by training providers are valid for only **six months** after taking the training class.
- See WAC 365-230-160 for recertification requirements and 40 CFR 745.225 (c)(14)(i) for birth date requirements.
- You are required to provide the **last 4 digits** of your Social Security number as part of the application for certification as a lead-based paint professional in Washington State. This is a mandatory requirement and is based on the Federal Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996, PL 104-193 and Washington State Law RCW 26.23.150.
- Applications may take up to 90 days to process. Once your application is approved, your certificate will be sent to the e-mail address provided on this application. Badges will be sent to the home address. Any questions regarding the status of your application should be directed to [dano.summers@commerce.wa.gov](mailto:dano.summers@commerce.wa.gov).

### Photo Requirements

Submit **one** (1) recent digital photo. Photos should be approximately 2" x 2", with the head and shoulders taking up most of the photo area. (See illustration to right). Photos must be front view against a plain white background, no hats, headgear, or dark glasses. Digital photo must be in a PC-based format such as JPEG or PNG file. Digital photos must be submitted as an email attachment to: [dano.summers@commerce.wa.gov](mailto:dano.summers@commerce.wa.gov). Identify the photo you submit with the name of the applicant.



### Fee Requirements

The fee for certification is \$25 per specialty (discipline) and is **non-refundable**. We accept checks or money orders only, no credit cards or cash.
