Form A	Form A will be used to communicate the buildings' compliance and reporting progress. It also identifies the qualified person. It includes documentation of weather normalized Energy Use Intensity (EUI) and the calculated Energy Use Intensity target (EUIt) for the building. It requires uploading the building energy management plan and Operations and Maintenance (O&M) program as specified by Commerce.	Download Form A here. This is a physical form produced by Commerce that will be filled out, signed and uploaded to the Clean Buildings Portal. Include the energy management plan and O&M program documentation as specified by Commerce. The qualified person is responsible for submitting all documentation for compliance. Form B	Form B identifies the building activity and EUIt.	Log into the Clean Buildings Portal. Fill out the building details and activity type pages in the Clean Buildings Portal to fulfil the requirements of Form B.	Clean Buildings Portal: building details and building activity
Form C	Form C documents the energy-use intensity calculations of the building. It is a Washington state-specific report within ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager (ESPM). Form D	Form D summarizes energy audits. It is a Washington state-specific report within the Audit Template form of the U.S. Department of Energy's Energy Asset Score Tool. Form F	Form F is the Life Cycle Cost Analysis (LCCA) tool used for the investment criteria of the Clean Buildings Performance Standard. This tool was developed from the Office of Financial Management's LCCA tool with specific amendments unique to the Standard. LCCA is a process that compares the base energy use case of the existing building to the alternative case proposed by an ASHRAE Level II energy audit to evaluate the cost-effectiveness of energy efficiency measures (EEMs). The tool is used in documenting compliance with the investment criteria of the standard.	Download Form F here.
